

THE 4TH BRANCH LAUNCHES NEW WEBSITE & PETITION



4 August 2018

To: 4^{th} Branch member organization representative.

Subject: Campaign to increase registration on the 4^{th} Branch and advocacy efforts for extension of the Bailey-Patton Amendment.

1. We have made a significant investment into developing and managing our 4th Branch website. The 4th Branch is fighting for fair and equitable treatment for **all** government retirees with regard to the taxation of earned retirement benefits. The 4th Branch provides updates on pending legislation in the NC General Assembly and serves as an umbrella organization for the more than 300,000 individuals in our state who are impacted. The 4th Branch also provides access to a very easy-to-use online advocacy system. Through the system, you can receive legislative and policy alerts as well as send your own messages to legislators, using their pre-written yet customizable messages. Being an advocate takes only a few minutes! However, the

success of this program is only as good as the numbers of registrants and their dedication to responding to Calls for Action. We do know from our communication experts that the key to getting better response rates is to increase the numbers in our data base. We currently have less than 6,500 registrants. We have tried a number of techniques to increase those numbers with basically minimal results. Recently, the SEANC Board of Governors has taken a bold approach and that was to approve forwarding their mailing list directly to Sherry Melton and Charles Hodges. They have the clearance to handle sensitive information which of course will not be made available to anyone else and use our system with many safeguards to ensure security of that information. We are now asking the leadership of every one of our 4th Branch member organizations to strongly consider doing the same

- 2. As we must be best prepared for the start of the next legislative session, we ask that you consult with your organization boards / chapters and work to accomplish what SEANC was able to do. I hope to have your response/status report no later than 31 August 2018. Please also include what techniques you and your chapters have used to get the word out about the 4th Branch and our Keep the Promise Campaign.


