Mark Sandvigen, Legislative Chair of the North Carolina COC that the Major Richard Star Act (H.R. 1282) has been approved in House Committee and has been moved to the full House. We are very hopeful this bill comes to a vote soon. As a reminder, this bill allows what is called "Concurrent Receipt" which means that service members who were seriously combat injured, requiring their release from active duty (and thus preventing retirement benefits) would be eligible not only for V.A. disability pay, but also an adjusted benefit based on their years of service in lieu of retirement. MOAA has been advocating for this benefit for many months and we are now getting closer to passage.

<u>Please support this effort by contacting your Congressional Representative and Senators</u>. The easiest way to do this is from the MOAA website (MOAA.org) in the Legislative Action Center. You will need to login (separate from the MOAA login) and then go to the Legislative Campaign entitled "Support Concurrent Receipt". Pre-written letters are there to all your legislators which you may very easily submit. There is strength in numbers, so the more people submit letters, the more powerful the message.

<u>Membership Requirements:</u> Commissioned and Warrant Officers of the eight uniformed services (Army, Navy, Air Force, Space Force, Marine Corps, Coast Guard, National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration and U.S. Public Health Service) and the reserve and other components of these services may become regular members.

Widows and widowers of any deceased individual, who would, if living, are eligible for membership. Regular members must hold and maintain membership in both the national organization as well as the local Chapter. Spouse members are encouraged but not required to hold both memberships.
